In this interesting editorial, Liu et al summarized the current knowledge on the aberrant regulation of canonical and non canonical Wnt signaling as a critical mechanism in the development of hepatocellular carcinoma (HCC). They also discussed the evidences which show that the Wnt pathway might contribute to HCC progression through the crosstalk with other signaling cascades. These concepts are summarized in three images. The manuscript is clearly written, well-organized and presented critically. In my opinion, its publication is appropriated. I only have a minor comment: authors should carefully revise the entire manuscript because there are several typographical mistakes and also, use of English revision is needed in many paragraphs.
