We are very grateful for all the comments and suggestions. We have revised the manuscript accordingly:-

Comments from reviewer (01213276) and our response:

1. It is a little bit unclear why the sample is narrowed only to children and adolescent with BMI from 40. to 60. percentiles, since the physiological nutritional status ranges from 15. to 85.percentiles.

Response: We chose this BMI percentile range because we wanted youngsters who were 'lean' in weight status, and to make sure we didn't include those somewhat underweight (<40 percentile) or those moving toward overweight (>60 percentile) we narrowed the sample.

2. Assessment of endothelial function was evaluated on a sample of only 32 children or adolescents, which is insufficient number for inference. The study should be called "pilot study", according to the tested sample.

Response: Most trials looking at the impact of exercise on endothelial function in children have small samples (around 20 or less per group) - see Metanalysis on obese children in Pediatrics (136(3), September 2015). Detectable changes in FMD are reported and therefore with a sample of 32 we believe we are sufficiently powered to detect differences within and between groups. Of course there are limitations and possible sampling error with a smaller sample; however, with the already published studies in this area, this would no longer be considered pilot work and we would prefer to retain the study as a pragmatic trial.
