

"There is no standard treatment for eradication, gastric mucosa Because the possibly of a host can be colonized by multiple strains of *H. pylori*, and susceptible and resistant Eventually coexist to the anti-microbial isolates, This phenomenon, not studied in Colombia difficult the eradication of the organism and does not allow to establish the therapeutic efficacy as a strategy for prevention of precursor lesions of GC". The paragraph was rewritten according to the suggestions of the reviewer, allowing to understand the postulate in a better way.
7. It is clarified that the type of format consent that was applied is the informed consent.
8. English translation of the results, discussion and all paper was reviewed and was polished by a native american teacher.
