Reviewer 1 : Very good: accept

Comments:

The authors have conducted a well-written study based on sound methods. The manuscript flows easily and with clarity. The case selection and choice of the important variables were appropriate and clinically relevant. The graphs and the tables are to the point and summarizing the main results of the study in an appropriate fashion. The retrospective nature limits the study, and the analysis would benefit from a propensity score matching to match the cases better and hence give stronger inference. Also, the study is not powered, and despite the relatively large sample size, we think it's better being powered given a large number of independent variables.
