**(1)- Reviewer No 02440197:** The manuscript investigated the validation of a chronic liver disease questionnaire in Serbian CLD patients. The study is of clinical significance. There are some questions for the authors:

Question 1: Were the patients undergoing antiretroviral therapy excluded in the study?

Answer 1: We excluded the patients undergoing antiretroviral therapy from the study. This sentence has been put in the section Material and method (at the end of the 1st paragraph).

Question 2: Did viral infection affect the chronic liver disease questionnaire scores?

Answer 2: The CLDQ scores were not influenced by viral infection. The results regarding analysis of etiology-specific scores of CLDQ has been added and described in the Results (Page 7, Section 2). This was followed with appropriate part in Discussion (Page 9, Section 5).

**(2)-Reviewer No 00053419:** The manuscript from Popovic et al reports the validation of a chronic liver disease questionnaire in Serbian patients. Evaluation of health related quality of life is a very relevant issue

as life expectancy for several chronic diseases has increased significantly. Adaptation of a preexisting questionnaire instead of proposing an alternative procedure allows comparison with results from other patient communities allowing cross-cultural validations and future refinements. Following are some minor questions for the authors' consideration: The results require more extensive discussion.

Question 1: Has the responsiveness of the Serbian CLDQ to change over time or after therapy been assessed?

Answer 1: Due to cross-sectional design we tested study participants only at one point in time and therefore we did not assess follow-up data regarding changes over time or after therapy.

Question 2: Did the authors found any correlation with the etiology of the disease? Do viral infections have any impact on the CLDQ score?

Answer 2: The results regarding analysis of etiology-specific scores of CLDQ has been added and described in the Results (Page 7, Section 2). This was followed with appropriate part in Discussion (Page 9, Section 5).

Question 3: The total CLDQ score values indicated in the first sentence of the second paragraph on page 9 should be revised.

Answer 3: We corrected as suggested.

**(3)-Reviewer No 00054986:** Congratulations on your article which is well written and is a good initiative to better understand the repercussions of chronic liver disease on the quality of life of these patients. I have made some suggestions in the manuscript and would request you to improve and expand the results section.
