We have revised our manuscript based on your great suggestions and provide below a point-by-point response to your comments. Our responses are highlighted in red.

Thank you for the interesting and important problem description. Please note that some minor language polishing will be needed, because you have to agree on verbs used and then follow these agreements. I also think it will be better to change the word "attenuated" with "weaker", "lower", "reduced" or something like this, because "attenuate" is rather used in different context. Please note that there are also some words in your text that miss a letter: "potential recall" - potential? In general, the article is very good, as it is the first one describing the relationship between liver functions and physical fitness in your part of the world. However I strongly recommend you to have it read by English native speaker to make it excellent.
