With respect to manuscript entitled '**Clinical variants of Pityriasis rosea**' (N °33073), the following corrections were done, as suggested for a Revision-Minireview manuscript:

- Correction of first page was done; Postal codes were included.
- Signed Conflict of Interest statement is attached.
- Audio core tip is included.
- Reference numbers were changed to square brackets.
- Construction of two Tables was done, as suggested, both cited in the text (in red).
- PMID and DOI citations were included (those that were found).
- Eyes were eliminated from Figure 5A.
- A new citation suggested by one of the reviewers was included (in red in the text):
A statement about the management of PR has been recently raised.^[57] Main conclusions include an adequate diagnosis, impact of the eruption in the quality of life since many patients do not necessitate any treatment, and use of oral acyclovir 400 mg three times daily for seven days, when not contraindicated or possible adverse effects are suspected.
- With respect to step 4 (manuscript title and Google scholar search), I really do not understand what do you mean or need. I introduced the current title, and nearly 5.000 citations appeared. I believe our title is correct and it summarizes perfectly what was written.
