REVIEWER 1(#02155440):

Comments:

1 . The result section is smart, but the table 1 can be deleted, and the content can be added to the text.

*Response:*

The table 1 has been deleted, and its content was added to the article as *The 2DUS imaging revealed 50 (13.9%) and 310 (86.1%) sets of the image were determined as grades 1 and 2, respectively, and none..... In 3DUS, 50 (13.9%) and 287 (79.7%) blocks were graded as 1 and 2, and the other 23.....* (Page 8, Lines 30-31~ Page 9, Lines 1-3, Results).

2. The discussion section is good, and the references is updating.

*Response:*

One new reference (Ref 17) was added as *US can provide an indirect evaluation of stomach relaxation and intragastric pressure by measuring the size of the stomach*<sup>[17]</sup>(Page 9, line 25, Discussion).

Two old references (Ref 4, 7) were updated as *The pathogenesis of FD is still unknown, but several studies have indicated that the proximal stomach, which includes the fundus and the proximal one-third of the body, is the site of an accommodation disorder that is likely to substantially contribute to the pathogenesis of FD*<sup>[3-5]</sup>(Page 4, line 9, Introduction), and *It is thought to be a vagally mediated reflex that occurs post-prandially and results in reduction of tone, providing a reservoir for the meal*<sup>[7]</sup> (Page 4, line 11, Introduction).

Some of the references that are not so fresh are still kept, because they are classic in this topic.

3. Some minor spelling errors should be corrected.

*Response:*

The spelling were checked again and some errors were rectified, and the following table has listed the details.
