It may reflect lack of editing by Dr. Fine. For example, Introduction, line 8: "Interestingly, no association has been noted between the development of KS and either duration of UC disease activity. This sentence is incomplete. Also, please take out the s from backgrounds (line 3). There is no shortage of many more throughout the report. Apart from this, I have no hard words for you.
