Reviewer 00504581 reply : CT abdomen revealed atrophic pancreas with pseudocyst suggestive of chronic pancreatitis. Patient also had history of recurrent episodes of abdominal pain in past.

Reviewer 00183658 reply : (1) The patient didn't give consent for therapeutic interventions like endoscopic transpapillary or transmural drainage, percutaneous catheter drainage or open surgery. In spite of counseling the patient about the advantages of intervention, patient was reluctant for any form of intervention.

(2) Standard treatment including indications for surgery are included in discussion which is highlighted in edited version.
