


Animal care and use statement

Title: Emodin and baicalein inhibit sodium taurocholate-induced vacuole formation in pancreatic acinar cells

The animal handling protocol was designed to minimize pain or discomfort to the animals. The animals were acclimatized to laboratory conditions for two weeks before experimentation. The animals were kept under defined conventional conditions (temperature: 19-21 °C, humidity: 30-70%, day-night cycle of 12h with light changes at 6:00 am and 6:00 pm) with up to three per cage. The conditions were recorded hourly by sensor and were personally controlled daily. The animals had access to food and water ad libitum. All animals were euthanized by sodium pentobarbital for tissue collection.
