Your attempt to bench mark against established guidelines of Western countries is valuable particularly in Asian countries in which the incidence of IBD however, I have some questions to clarify your conclusions 1> The number of colonoscopy performed by four trainee is heterogeneous from 19 to 44. Can you show us the rough data of their learning curves. 2> Cecal intubation success rate is so crucial in pediatric colonoscopy to make a diagnosis of Crohn's disease and to rule out atypical pediatric ulcerative colitis. Can you suggest how many cases are needed at least to achieve acceptable cecal success rate. 3> It will be more informative if you show us the causes of intubation failure. If you propose how to overcome low cecal intubation rate in Discussion section, it will be more helpful to readers.
