- (1) More precise pathology report of the specimen in Case 1 has been offered.
- (2) Type of ectopic liver (due to Collan classification) in both cases was determined.
- (3) Axial CT image of ectopic liver in spleen (Case 2) was added (Figure 4).
- (4) Preoperative and postoperative histology (Case 2) of ectopic liver was specified, figure of postoperative histology was added.
- (5) Clarification of PET-CT indication in Case 2 was offered.
- (6) Term “toxonutritive hepatopathy” was specified.
- (7) Orthotopic liver tissue (in Case 2) was negative for HCC, although histological verification was not done.
- (8) Discussion was shortened, focused on other reports of malignancy in ectopic liver.
- (9) Reference about incidence of HCC in ectopic liver in Japan was specified.

4 Revision has been made according to the suggestions of the reviewer No. 00053844:


- (1) Rationale for systemic therapy by sorafenib in Case 2 has been offered and discussed.
