SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

The authors reported a rare case of primary gastrointestinal amyloidosis with multiple nodular protuberances in the digestive tract, with controllable moderate abdominal discomfort and anemia and a benign course. Enteroscopy with biopsy and endoscopic



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ultrasonography played an important role in the diagnosis of primary gastrointestinal amyloidosis. This case is certainly a rare and unique case with a benign nature. However, the authors should investigate the subtype of amyloidosis, and examine bone marrow to rule out multiple myeloma. Previous reports revealed that there were cases of AL amyloidosis resulted from multiple myeloma in which serum and urine protein electrophoresis were both negative for monoclonal gammopathy. In this paper, discussion section should be written more briefly.
