The authors report on 23 recurrent carpal tunnel syndrome from over 400 patients treated. I like the manuscript, although data may show a better graphical presentation. The authors should also expand the evolution of CTS decompression surgery with open

technique, which was first performed by Herbert Galloway in 1924 and later described by Sir James Learmont in 1933. They should add a table showing the milestones of the decompression surgery that have been perused during the last 80 years.
