Abstract

AIM

To investigate if minority ethnicity and duration of education influence preoperative disability and expectations in patients undergoing total knee arthroplasty.

METHODS

We prospectively included 829 patients undergoing primary unilateral total knee arthroplasty (TKA) from April 2013 to December 2014 at a single centre. Patients filled in pre-operative questionnaires with information regarding place of birth, duration of education, expectations to outcome of surgery and baseline characteristics. Patients were stratified based on ethnicity. Majority ethnicity defined as born in the study country and minority ethnicity defined as born in all other countries.
