The Administering Institution acknowledges that the Specified Personnel will receive a research implementation, consultation and outreach loading to participate in the NHMRC National Institute for Dementia Research and may, therefore, be required to participate in additional activities from time to time, including supplementary research and collaborative activities, as directed by the Institute.

The Administering Institution agrees to provide reasonable, additional reporting to the NHMRC National Institute for Dementia Research as required, to inform its work plan and subsequent research activities.

The Administering Institution agrees that the Specified Personnel will provide reasonable support to the NHMRC National Institute for Dementia Research in any other circumstances,

including participation in an evaluation of the elements of the Boosting Dementia Research Initiative, currently planned for 2018/19.
