a) It's an interesting paper, but it is not clear how the device helps in the location of the capsule.

Thank you! I hope -through our revision- it is clear that we propose is a small-bowel lesion localization conceptual capsule design (odometer; in relation to pylorus) and not a capsule localization system in 3d space.

b) Interesting idea, congratulations. The first video record is not possible to play, the second is of a

very poor quality and four-years-old! You must have better videos after 4 years of experiments. Why do you not applied the new capsule on animal model (pigs for example) after such a long time? Capsule endoscopy on a porcine model is possible

(see Tacheci et al., Dig Dis Sci - see the attachment) Which further experiments do you plan? Specify.

Thank you! The experiments were performed in June 2013. Video links have been checked and they are now working; as for the last reference, it has been added.
