(1) Question from reviewer number 00181214: 21 colon cancers enrolled in 11 months looks not really a relevant number. Authors should clarify their hospital volume (number of colectomies performed for cancer and number of standard endoscopies performed for cancer each year). Moreover even though

authors declared to have calculate the sensitivy, specificity, PPV, NPV of the EUS and of the standard radiology, the show exclusively the accuracy results. These data need to be reported (also in tables).

a) Answer: A sentence of “During the study time, 82 patients with colon cancer located beyond rectum underwent colectomy. Twenty-one patients (25.6%) were recruited into the study.” was added into the first part of results session.

b) Answer: Table 3 was added to clarify about diagnostic values.
