Your kind comments and suggestions are highly appreciated. Point-to-point reply to your comments is following:

- Per your valuable suggestion, we have noted in the introduction part that the current evidence about ERAS in emergency colorectal surgery and its outcomes in this editorial was mainly based on the studies of acutely obstructed colorectal cancer, not perforated hollow viscus and intraabdominal sepsis.
- We do agree with you that in the cases with perforation or abdominal abscess, preoperative ERAS items may not be able to use for the patients, so the intraoperative and postoperative items may be important for such conditions. Accordingly, we have added this statement in the part of 'perspectives of ERAS program in emergency colorectal surgery'.
- Per your valuable suggestion, we further described more about the difference in the ERAS items between patients with intraabdominal sepsis and those with just acute colonic obstruction in the part of 'perspectives of ERAS program in emergency colorectal surgery'.
