RE manuscript; 46516 “Congenital peritoneal encapsulation: A review and novel classification system”. Dave et al review the rare condition of congenital peritoneal encapsulation and compare features with two other similar (also rare or relatively rare) diseases, abdominal cocoon and encapsulating peritoneal sclerosis. They offer a



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classification system for encapsulating bowel diseases (novel) and a diagnostic outline for the congenital form of bowel encapsulation (also novel). Pathogenesis, diagnostic work up and management are discussed. Limitations are the lack of more long term outcome data available in the literature. I think the paper is well written, organized and is an important source of information on these rare disorders. I have no major criticisms and only minor comments. In the methods section it may be of interest to add a figure outlining total articles found and then to indicate the number of article excluded which pertained to the other two conditions. In figure 3. It may be useful to add an arrow or two to the central area outlining the demonstrated abnormality. Second can the letter A from the lower right side be removed? Or was there a B picture as well?
