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successful removal of the part of the portal vein infiltrated by the tumour ,and also the choice of repairing the portal vein with the teres ligament and the technique to do it. Despite the fact that there have already been other published experiences like this. This new communication will have sense if the authors would also thoroughly discuss other surgical alternatives to repairing the vein 1.- It would be interesting the authors discusses which other surgical alternatives did they have in order to repair the portal vein, and which have seen the related results. Is there any specific role for usefulness of artificial vascular graft for repairing the portal vein in this setting 2.- The authors should thoroughly explain and discuss the what is the scientific evidence-based for the implementation of ERAS with these specific preoperative measures , and specifically with the“ magnesium isoglycyrrhizinate was administered to protect the liver” etc..(ERAS)
