The manuscript has also been updated to incorporate recommendations and comments made by the reviewers. In particular, a paragraph was added to the discussion (and is highlighted yellow) summarizing our recommendations on what would be considered a good overall number of capsule studies required to achieve competence, which setting would be appropriate for training to be carried out, whether nurses and other non-physicians should be able to read capsules.
