Macrophage activation syndrome (MAS) is defined as a specific secondary hemophagocytic lymphohistiocytosis (HLH) that refers in particular to those triggered by autoimmune diseases. MAS is a rare and highly lethal complication of systemic lupus erythematosus (SLE), which can be associated with, or mimic, disease flare. Yet the data regarding the clinical course, management and outcome of SLE with MAS is limited, especially in adults. Lack of clinical recognition often leads to poor prognosis of the disease.
