Here we present eight thyroidal metastases from clear cell renal cell carcinoma (ccRCCC), including a tumor to tumor metastasis, the patients being 2 men and 6 women with a median age of 62 years. The majority had a past history of goiter and a single and palpable metastasis. In one patient the thyroid metastases were the first sign of the ccRCCC.

Clear cell tumors of the thyroid gland in general are uncommon. Metastatic renal cell carcinoma (RCC) to the thyroid gland is a rare occurrence but must be considered in the differential diagnosis of a thyroid gland clear cell neoplasm to prevent misclassification, potentially resulting in inappropriate clinical management

5 **BACKGROUND**

6 Thyroid gland is an uncommon site for metastases from clear cell renal cell carcinoma
7 (CCRCC) and literature is scarce. Due to the variable and often long lag time before
8 development of metastases in patients with CCRCC, thyroid nodules may be
9 misdiagnosed initially as benign. This systematic review aims at a better understanding
10 of the nature of these metastases.

12 **METHODS**

13 A bibliographic search was performed using PubMed (1990-2019), key words being
14 "renal cell carcinoma, thyroid, kidney cancer, clear cell." 147 cases were analyzed. The
15 patient's characteristics assessed were: age, sex, stage, size of metastases, lag time,
16 diagnostic modality, initial symptoms, treatment and outcome in last documented follow
17 up. Binary logistic regression, Spearman's rho and ANOVA were used to identify
18 differences between the existing variables.

20 **RESULTS**

21 The mean age (\pm SE) was $64 \pm (10)$ years in males and $64 (\pm 11)$ in females. The mean lag
22 time to diagnosis of thyroid metastases was $8.7 (\pm 6.3)$ years. Gender distribution of the
23 patients was 46.3% male, 52.4% female. There was a weak correlation between lag time
24 and size of metastases, not statistically significant. Size of metastases was significantly
25 higher in symptomatic patients (6.06 ± 3.51 cm) compared to those with painless mass
26 (4.6 ± 0.29 cm) and asymptomatic ones (3.93 ± 1.99 cm) ($P = 0.03$). Fine Needle Aspiration
27 was diagnostic in 29.4% of cases, 47.1% were non diagnostic. Most patients (80.3%)
28 underwent thyroid surgery. At 1 year follow up, 55.6% of patients operated were alive

Dec 10, 2013 · Clear cell renal carcinoma is the most frequent site of origin of thyroid metastases and represents 12 to 34% of all secondary thyroid tumors. Tumor-to-tumor metastases, in which a thyroid neoplasm is the recipient of a metastasis, are exceedingly rare. We report a case of clear cell renal carcinoma metastatic to a follicular adenoma.
