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This article entitled “Cryoablation combined with radiotherapy for hepatic malignancy: five cases reports” by Liu Ye et al is interesting in its field. The authors reported 5 cases of advanced-stage hepatic malignancies and analyzed a comprehensive program of cryoablation combined with radiotherapy for the treatment of hepatic malignancies. This article is well written with few typos inside. Here are some comments : 1. It would be better if authors provide a comprehensive table consisting those 5 cases and the differences 2. In the abstract authors mentioned the quality of life of the patient was significantly improved and the survival was prolonged while there is no criteria/definition or statistic test about the quality of life / prolonged survival were mentioned 3. In the abstract’s conclusion, author mentioned cryoablation combined with IMRT is a safe and effective treatment for hepatic malignancies. This conclusion is too far because no statistics finding and this study has only 5 case studies and 2 of them were death. 4. Please provide a structured description for each case
