This type of clinical case is relatively rare and therefore the handling of the case by medical team will make for a useful point of reference. My suggestion would be for only minor changes: put the clinical data in a more tabularized form, so for the laboratory examinations etc provide a normal range guide and then the clinical data for the patient concerned thereby highlighting the differences from normality.
