So far, a large number of cases of lumbar intraspinal cysts have been reported. In addition, the authors did not distinguish between lumbar facet joint synovial cysts and ganglion cysts. Although there are no significant clinical differences, there are some histopathological differences between synovial cysts and ganglion cysts.
