The paper by Wu et al. describes a case study of a meningitis patient infected with a multidrug-resistant strain of *Acinetobacter baumannii*. The paper is timely with the growth of antibiotic resistant strain of bacteria, particularly in healthcare settings. Overall, the paper is organized well with good supporting information. Only few minor changes need to be done as listed below. 1. The species name in the title as well as the species names in the various references need to be italicized. 2. On page 6, sixth row from the bottom, is should be "compound of the glycylycyline class". 3. Page 7, fourth line change to "Doxycycline is known to be active against MDRA and was administered to the patient following the failure of tigecycline." 4. Page 4, 15th line should be antibiotics, including tigecycline and colistin, diffuse".

With these results, both responses to treatment and side effects of drugs can be monitored. Also, especially the nephrotoxic effect of gentamicin should be monitored. Finally, the patient's clinical course should be better presented and understandable.
