## BPG's Revision Policies for Case Report



**1 Language evaluation:** (1) Grade A: priority publishing; (2) Grade B: minor language polishing; (3) Grade C: intensive language polishing; (4) Grade D: rejected. The language of revised articles should reach grade A.

### Policy for manuscripts submitted by non-native speakers of English

For manuscripts submitted by non-native speakers of English, the author(s) must seek to make use of a copyediting service provided by professional English language editing companies. The English language editing company you have chosen must send us a recommendation letter, in which the manuscript code should be specified, e.g., ESPS Ms NO: 666. Please pay attention to detail since only one opportunity for revision will be allowed. We only accept manuscripts edited by the following English language editing companies:

**Note:** If you believe that the language of your manuscript has reached or exceeded Grade A and would like to sign a guarantee, you can choose not to have your manuscript edited by the above English language editing companies. However, if we later find that the language of your manuscript has not reached Grade A, your paper will be rejected.

**2 Case Report:** Case Report should include detailed contents, comparisons and evaluations in relation to other published articles, and an in-depth discussion. At least 1 reference should be included, covering important publications cited in PubMed over the past four years. For key references, however, publication time is not strictly restricted.

**3 Responses to reviewers:** Please revise your article according to the reviewers' comments/suggestions. The format for responses to reviewers' comments is specified in the attached files.

**4 Title:** Title should be less than 12 words.

**5 Running Title:** A short running title of less than 6 words should be provided.

**6 Authorship:** According to the guidelines defined by the International Committee of Medical Journal Editors, authorship credit should be based on (1) substantial contributions to conception and design, acquisition of data, or analysis and interpretation of data; (2) drafting the article or revising it critically for important intellectual content; and (3) final approval of the version to be published. Authors should meet conditions 1, 2, and 3. Author contributions should be provided in detail.
