This case report seems to be well-written and interesting. As a reviewer, I have two minor requests. Minor points: #1 In the "Core tip" section, the first letter should be started with a capital letter. #2 Page 4 L59: The authors adopted "the present study" in the "Introduction" section, however, this was the case report. The authors should change it.
