<ul style="list-style-type: none">• This paper report a case of chondrosarcomas in the maxillofacial region, Computed tomography with 3-dimensional reconstruction was performed, and the osteolytic lesion affected the vestibular cortex of the palatal bone was observed. Hematoxylin and eosin staining revealed an appearance that was similar to mature hyaline cartilage, hypercellularity, nuclear and cellular pleomorphism, and multinucleated cells, with significant vacuolization.
