The authors have done a single center study in Spain. So you change the words "IN A MEDITERRANEAN SETTING" in the title. Avoid the exaggeration. Presence of anti-HDV IgG or IgM? Grammar should be improved. Subheading titles should be provided in the Results section. Because the title focused on CHANGING DELTA HEPATITIS PATIENT PROFILE, the Methods and Results sections should provide more data about this dynamic change. The authors did not compare with earlier data.

The title: I would recommend to use like this: Changing Delat hepatitis patient profile: a single center experience in Valencia region, Spain. Since this is a study from one medical center. This maybe more accurate to reflect the dynamic changes in a specific region. 2. Diagnosis of hepatitis: I would recommend to use HBsAg instead of Australian. As to anti-HDV, anti-HCV or anti-HIV, are they IgG or IgM?
