Answer: Thank you for the correction. ANCA biomarkers were detected in serum. We change table 1 with the correct setting of ANCAs.

Biomarkers section should reference colorectal mucous biomarker detection in IBD (Loktionov A, Chhaya V, Bandaletova T, Poullis A.J Gastroenterol Hepatol. 2017 May;32(5):992-1002).

Answer: Thank you for the comment. Colorectal mucous biomarkers have been added to table 1 biomarkers as described in Loktionov et al. paper.
