There are some suggestions for the authors:

In the section of "Neutrophil to lymphocyte ratio (NLR)" and "Albumin bilirubin grading system", the majority was devoted to the association between NLR and multiple diseases, but the association between NLR/ ALBI and HCC were not elaborated. Please make the topic clear and the contents well organized.

This section was moved to the introduction and summarised to further make the topic clear

2. In the section of "Discussion", please discuss the difference between results of your research and previous studies.

The study in our centre was similar to the results of the published literature and the systemic search carried in the manuscript and we highlighted the areas of similarities between the validation study in our centre and the systematic search findings

3. Stronger evidence may be needed for the conclusion of “ALBI grade performs better than CTP score”.

We reached this conclusion according to the systematic search and the ROC curve demonstrated in our validation cohort. We raise this point to encourage discussion among readers and also to highlight this emerging model for stakeholders interested in HCC management

“HCC literature continues to report on studies from around the world aiming to find simpler prognostic markers for the disease. Linear predictive models generated from large data sets were shown to be able to prognosticate for HCC patients. ^[7,8] Indeed, simpler prognostic ways are required given the complexity of the intermediate stage of HCC. ^[9] The emerging literature describes two new markers in HCC prognosis, the Neutrophil to Lymphocyte Ratio (NLR) and the Albumin Bilirubin (ALBI) grade.”
