<b>Introduction</b>	4	One or two paragraphs summarizing why this case is unique ( <b>may include references</b> )	Background, paragraph 1,2
<b>Patient Information</b>	5a	De-identified patient specific information.	Case presentation, all paragraphs
	5b	Primary concerns and symptoms of the patient.	Case presentation, all paragraphs
	5c	Medical, family, and psycho-social history including relevant genetic information	Case presentation, all
	5d	Relevant past interventions with outcomes	Case presentation, all paragraphs
<b>Clinical Findings</b>	6	significant physical examination (PE) and important clinical findings.	Case presentation, all paragraphs
<b>Timeline</b>	7	Historical and current information from this episode of care organized as a timeline	Case presentation, all
<b>Diagnostic Assessment</b>	8a	Diagnostic testing (such as PE, laboratory testing, imaging, surveys).	Case presentation, all
