(1) The novelty and impact of this work seem limited since no dramatic progress has been made in this field in the recent couple of years, and similar review papers have been published in other journals. (2) The review appears to be general and descriptive, lacking clear explanation and deep discussions of underlying mechanisms. (3) The figures could be made clearer and more intuitive, and the writing could be improved as well.
