Recognized adverse prognostic factors include tumors located in the anal canal as opposed to anal margin or perianal skin cancers, locally **advanced tumors** including **tumors** greater than 5 cm (T3), tumors of any size that invade adjacent organ such as the **vagina**, **urethra**, or **bladder** (T4), **lymph node involvement**, and probably being **HIV-positive**, particularly for patients with CD4 lymphocyte counts ...
