I am uploading the copy of the revised manuscript along with my response to the reviewers' points. The summary of the changes made were as follow:

We modified the manuscript based on the comments made by the editor and the reviewer.

1. Postal codes were added to all authors
2. Contribution of each author to the manuscript was provided.
3. Table 2 was cited in the results section.
4. References were cited throughout the text inside the brackets.
5. References were modified to reflect the required formatting including the PMID and DOI of each article in brackets. Some articles miss either one of these two Id's. But all of them include at least one of them.
6. Legends were added to the footage of both figures.
7. However, we were unable to make the figures decomposable as it was directed by the editor after so many tries.
8. The core tip section was added as suggested.
9. Since the Conclusion section was not a mandatory field, we removed this section and included its content in the comment section, which was requested by the editor. However, the authors could not access the Peer Review text from the website. We were wondering if the editorial staff is able to copy the comments of the reviewer in this section.
