A total of 30 references are cited, including 1 reference published in the last 3 years. There are 2 self-citations. 2 Language evaluation: Classification: Grade A. The language was edited by one native English speaker. 3 Academic norms and rules: The authors provided the Biostatistics Review Certificate, the signed Conflict-of-Interest Disclosure Form and Copyright License Agreement, CONSORT 2010 Statement, the Institutional Review Board Approval Form and Written informed consent. The Clinical Trial Registration Statement was waived. No academic misconduct was found in the CrossCheck detection and Bing search. 4 Supplementary comments: This is an unsolicited manuscript. The study was supported by 1 grant. The topic has not previously been published in the WJCC. 5 Issues raised: (1) The authors did not provide the approved grant application form(s). Please upload the approved grant application form(s) or funding agency copy of any approval document(s); and (2) The "Article Highlights" section is missing. Please add the "Article Highlights" section at the end of the main text. 6 Re-Review: Not required. 7 Recommendation: Conditional acceptance.
