- Some new information and some new references (about the life and the works of Avicenna) were added.
- The abstract was changed.
- A figure was added. As they (NLM) responded to our question, this figure is on the public domain of NLM and needs no permission.
- The original Arabic titles of chapters of Canon were added.
- Please note that based on the literature, the “Canon of Medicine” is a common translation of “Al-Qanun-fi-al-Tibb”; however, we added “The Law of Medicine” to the text. In addition, Avicenna and Ibn Sina are commonly used as the names of this physician within the scientific literature.
- It should be stated that we did not use Wikipedia in writing of this manuscript. This paper was prepared based on the Shrafkandi A. Persian translation of Canon.
- Some new phrases were added to the text. The aim was to better clarify Avicenna’s main contributions.
- Postal code was added to the affiliations.
- The title of manuscript underwent a little change to better match with the content.
- Changes were highlighted.
