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The patient remains in complete remission 40 months after **diagnosis** and 26 months after initiation of **treatment**. In the **case of concurrent gastric and intestinal** low grade **MALT-type lymphoma**, H pylori eradication may **cause** regression of the intestinal lesion.

Majority of those are **B-cell lymphomas**. Most common ones are diffuse large **cell lymphoma** and **marginal zone lymphoma** of **mucosa-associated lymphoid tissue (MALT)**. Other **B-cell lymphomas** are Burkitt's **lymphoma**, **mantle cell lymphoma**, and **follicular lymphoma**. 1-2% of adult **non-Hodgkin's lymphomas** are Burkitt's **lymphoma**.
