Title can be modified. Abstract: satisfactory. Case report: Well documented. Discussion is quite elaborate and provides most of the details. However in the said case there was no need to consider hepatic hydatid as one of the differentials. The imaging findings are quite clear. Conclusion is quite satisfactory.

Authors' answers

Thank you for your positive answer! Based on your opinion, we have removed the part about differential diagnosis with hepatic hydatid. The title was also modified.

Reviewer's 2 opinion

It is a well-written manuscript. The patient's information is detailed and the pathology result is clear and confirmed. The discussion part is thorough. But I have to say that missing data of CEA, AFP and HCG is a little drawback. And in the second paragraph of Case Presentation-Imaging examinations, 10UH should be 10HU.

Authors' answers

Thank you for your precious time spent on doing this review. We have changed 10 UH with 10 HU. Lack of serum analysis might be considered a weak point but, to compensate, we have included a histological examination in detail and, based on your suggestion, we have performed immunostains with the mentioned biomarkers and all of them were negative. We have inserted in blue, in Results, this fact.
