This article is of interest since it describes novel coronavirus pneumonia that has an atypical presentation. However, there are several issues that require correction. Major: According to the JAMA article (Wang D, Hu B, Hu C, Zhu F, Liu X, Zhang J, Wang B, Xiang H, Cheng Z, Xiong Y, Zhao Y, Li Y, Wang X, Peng Z. Clinical Characteristics of 138 Hospitalized Patients With 2019 Novel Coronavirus-Infected Pneumonia in Wuhan, China. JAMA. 2020 Feb 7. doi: 10.1001/jama.2020.1585. [Epub ahead of print]), approximately 10% of those infected with “COVID-19” present with diarrhea. Similarly, the article in JAMA includes a certain amount of information on frequencies of each symptom; thus, these should also be included in Discussion of the main text. Minor: The World Health Organization (WHO) named the “novel coronavirus pneumonia” “COVID-19” on February 11, 2020. All references to the "novel coronavirus pneumonia" should be revised accordingly to "COVID-19".

SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

The authors report an atypical case of novel coronavirus pneumonia. Publications related to novel coronavirus (2019-nCov) infection would contribute to literature. Although this case report is valuable for comprehensive understanding of clinical presentation of 2019-nCov infection, the paper could be better written: i) the new name of novel coronavirus which is “2019-nCov” could be placed in Title, Abstract, etc., ii) the English could be polished and some typographical errors must be corrected; iii) the Abstract could be concise; iv) core tip should give information about the case; v) the citation could be presented as “1-3” instead of “1, 2, 3”, etc.; vi) the abbreviations could better be used; vii) subsections in Case Presentations are unnecessary; some statements are not suitable for medical terminology for example “palpation” instead of “pressure” for abdominal examination, “myalgia” instead of “sore muscle”, “chest CT” instead of “CT”, etc.; viii) presentation of laboratory results are inappropriate which could be concise with reference ranges; ix) trade names of drugs in the text are inappropriate; x) is the statements of “0.4 QD”, “0.2 TID”, “five million BID” are appropriate; xi) the Figure 2 is unnecessary; xii) detailed clarifications in figure legends could be moved to Case Presentation.
