The new technique join a new way of percutaneous expanded core decompression with subsequent bone graft. The results seems to be excellent and a careful patient selection should be applied. The study com pare only three patients with the new technique with three patients treated with the older technique. The results are interesting and useful for physicians involved with such problems. The authors should be encouraged in going on with their technique

(1) Science Editor: 1 Scientific quality: The manuscript describes a retrospective study of modified technique of advanced core decompression for treatment of femoral head osteonecrosis. The topic is within the scope of the WJCC. (1) Classification: Grade B; (2) Summary of the Peer-Review Report: The reviewer thinks it is a well written and interesting manuscript describing a new technique for the treatment of femoral head osteonecrosis. The result seems to be excellent and a careful patient selection should be applied. The results are interesting and useful for physicians involved with such problems. (3) Format: There is 1 table. A total of 30 references are cited, including 4 references published in the last 3 years. There is no self-citation. 2 Language evaluation: Classification: Grade A. Three of the authors are native speakers of English. 3 Academic norms and rules: The authors provided the Signed Informed Consent Form and the Institutional Review Board Approval Form. The authors signed the Conflict-of-Interest Disclosure Form and the Copyright License Agreement. The Biostatistics Review Certificate was not provided. No academic misconduct was found in the CrossCheck detection and Bing search. 4 Supplementary comments: This is an unsolicited manuscript. The study was supported by the merit grant from the Department of Veterans Affairs and the Veterans Administration Medical Center in Memphis, the University of Tennessee Health Science Center, and the first hospital of Qiqihar city. The topic has not previously been published in the WJCC. 5

A: We have added DOI numbers to most of the references in the list. But we can't find the numbers of PMID and DOI for the reference fourteenth and twenty-first.. The fourteenth is an article published in Chinese Journal, we only found its article number. The twenty-first is an article published in 1965 without such IDs.
