The manuscript has been improved according to the suggestions of reviewers:

1. Page 3: Line 9: "Fig.1" is altered to "Fig. 1A and B"
2. Page 4: Line 22: "fistula tract" is altered to "fistulous tract"
3. bowel cleanse interval, nutritional care and fasting duration, kind of antibiotics and duration were shown in graph1 and numerical tick marks were drawn on the horizontal axis.
4. PEG administration dose and interval was described as "Namely, a liter of PEG solution was administrated orally every morning and afternoon then checked the number of defecation. If it was checked two times or less, additional solution (0.5 liter of PEG) was taken in the evening."
5. Gallstone was not seen in CT exam, but according to a report "Predicting gallstone pancreatitis with laboratory parameters: a meta-analysis. *Am J Gastroenterol* 1994; 89:1863-1866", ERCP was performed for suspected gallstone pancreatitis.
6. Another figure was added in figure 2 and fistula portion was indicated using yellow circle.
7. References and typesetting were corrected
8. All submissions must be typed in 1.5 line spacing and in Book Antiqua font of size 10 with ample margins.
