However, based on what you found; you didn't have direct evidence to indicate the relationship with EMT. Due to just one case, compared with discussion with molecular mechanism of the disease onset, I would like to recommend you to clarify the characters of this rare case and differential diagnosis, This is more effective to clinic work.
