Pit patterns III (tubular) and **IV** (branch or gyrus-like) indicate neoplasia (usually tubular or **tubulovillous adenoma**). **Pit pattern V** (irregular nonstructured) suggests advanced neoplasia with possible submucosal invasion. Narrow-band imaging (Olympus) was used at the discretion of the endoscopist to assist with pit pattern classification.
