

Based on the issues in the manuscript of the peer review report, we made the following amendments:

1. we have moved the pathological results of postoperative specimens from the section of "imaging examination" to the section of "Pathological examinations" for description.

2. In the "Discussion" part of the manuscript (page 5, lines 15-18), we explained that the reason why the patient didn't do abdominal enhanced CT but only did ordinary abdominal CT was that the patient suddenly suffered from fatal gastrointestinal bleeding. In order to save the patient's life, we performed emergency surgery and failed to complete the examination of abdominal enhanced CT.

3. We have adjusted the aspect ratio of all pictures.

4. In the discussion part, we discussed that the formation mechanism of ectopic varicose veins is regional mesenteric vascular occlusion caused by huge duodenal stromal tumor compression. Pathological findings of excised specimens support the mechanism of this hypothesis, as shown in fig. 4C.

5. In the "Discussion" section, we have increased the discussion of endoscopic technology, and mentioned that according to the operation level of endoscopists and the patient's condition, we can choose intravenous injection of sclerosing agent, tissue glue or clamping varicose veins with metal clips, among which clamping ectopic veins of unknown origin with metal clips is considered to be a safe and effective treatment method.

6. We have added "author's contribution" to the front page of the manuscript (page 1, lines 16-18)

7. We have provided the PMID and DOI in the reference list. and listed all the authors of the reference.

8. We have used PowerPoint to prepare and arrange the original figures to ensure that the editor can reprocess all graphics or arrows or text parts.
