The present study describes the various findings of a case of LPRM with atypical cystic solid features in a man (36yrs) who presented the common clinical signs and symptoms of the disease, as well as CT and MRI features. Some uncommon imaging findings, such as multiple cysts of nonuniform size and thin wall around the solid part, were also observed that might increase misdiagnosis rate. The definitive diagnosis of LPRM relied on histopathological findings. The study is interesting since it provides information on a rare form of neoplasm. However, the m/s requires language revision (grammar, syntax and typo errors).

However, there are remaining some points in revised version requiring the attention of the authors. 1. There are no figures submitted in the revised form, although there are the legends, being the same as in the initial form of the manuscript. However, Figure 1 was submitted as supplementary material. 2. Lines 186 & 188: There are two sequential sentences starting with “In our case”. 3. Lines 96-113: Include the opinion or the consultation of experts without the name of the consultant. Moreover, since both consultants are authors of the manuscript, their opinion should be written in one paragraph. 4. Line 140: replace “is” with “was”. 5. The section “CONCLUSION” is written two times.
